

# Bulldogs, Cal Western clash here tonight

University of Redlands Bulldogs will attempt to gain the win column tonight when they host powerful California Western at 8 o'clock in the second pre-season game.

Coach Frank Serrao's charges have been unable to down the Westerners in their last three meetings but hope is that the tables will be turned tonight.

Cal Western coach Bob Dinaberg has a new look squad with all-NAIA All-American halfback Jackman LeBlanc switched to fullback. LeBlanc is a rugged 6 foot 195 pounder.

Other starters in the Westerner backfield will be quarterback Wayne Clark, 6-3, 210, a converted end; right half Pete Werhanowicz, 6-2, 194 and the lightest man in the backfield left half Mike Rhodes at 5-9, 165.

The offensive line will average over 200 pounds with such players as Leonard DeSanti, 252, at left tackle, Jim Regan, 195, at left guard, Morris Muench, 195, at center, Bill Bennett, 210, at right guard, Marshall Cochrane, 225, at right tackle, Frank Vaughn, 210, at right end and Jim Antl, 160, at left end.

To counter the Westerners weight advantage, the Bulldogs hope lies in their aerial attack with quarterback John Hoak guiding the bombs. Receiving will be Bill Hoover and Don Ford at the ends.

Other receivers will be wingback Greg Keller and halfback Flip Rondares. Rick Dischinger opens at full for the Bulldogs.

In the interior line will be Dave Wheeler and Marty Link at the tackles Tom Rees and Chuck Baker at the guards and Dick Holmes at center.

Defensively, the UR forces are expected to go with Ted Hedgpath and John Romo at the ends, Mike McGinn and Ron Grout at the tackles and Tim Kerwin at middle guard.

Jerry Pesce, Gary Wilson and Gary Ovitt will be the linebackers with Ford, Gary Wiseman and Chip Chiappone as the deep backs.

For his outstanding play in the Cal State Hayward game, including an intercepted pass, Chiappone was named Bulldog of the Week by the coaching staff.

The 5-10, 170 pound junior was a gridiron star at Yucaipa high school before enrolling at UR.
