# USIU Notches Season Ending Victory

Jeff Morrow returned a seasonal record kickoff 95 yards to a touchdown and Scott Holland scampered 33 yards with a pass interception to lead United States International University's football team to a 22-15 victory over Azusa-Pacific yesterday at Mt. Carmel High's field.

The season-ending victory, combined with a forfeit win confirmed earlier this week over the University of Redlands, leaves USIU with a 3-8

Morrow's kickoff return and Holland's interception were the key plays as coach Shan Deniston's Westerners turned back two Azusa-Pacific threats in the closing seconds to clinch the win.

Azusa-Pacific's Greg Mahood matched Morrow's kickoff return on the kick following Morrow's sprint, and the visitors got close on a final-quarter touchdown

pass from Ric Dutton to Randy McElwen of 44 yards.

USIU managed one scoring drive in the game, marching 46 yards following a fumble recovery. A pass from Roy Blakeway to Jimbo Harris of 20 yards was the big play in the advance, and Blakeway later plunged over from the two.

Harris has been alternating with Blakeway at quarterback all season, but filled

in as a running back in the final contest.

Wayne Thompson had recorded a safety with 4:40 to play in the first quarter to account for USIU's first two points.

The Westerners' defense stopped Azusa-Pacific drives at the USIU 15 and, with 1:30 remaining, at the 32 yard line to allow the Westerner offense to run out the clock in the final seconds.
