In addition, USIU saw a 15-yard TD pass from Omer to Fultz and a 50-yard pass to Tim Titus to the enemy two yard line called back on penalties.

Officials marked off 98 yards on nine penalties against USIU against none for the Gators in the first half alone. The total penalty yardage went against the Westerners, 135-52.

A dogged USIU defense, led by cornerback Hatcher, tackles Mary Bethea and Pat Irby and linebacker Alan Torretto limited the Gators to 67 yards rushing.

The Westerners also found themselves a kicker in sophomore Dean Bradshaw from Rio Hondo College who averaged 46.3 yards on six punts including one of 56 yards.

Omer passed 14 yards to Titus and carried twice for 12 yards to set up Nugent from the one for USIU with seven minutes gone in the first period. The Gators tied it with 37 seconds left in the same quarter when Billoups

raced 53 yards. The winners then went ahead to stay in the second quarter, going 71 yards in 10 plays with Omer hitting Fultz for the final 29 with 12:16 to play in the half.

After the third-period safety, Rocky Lucia, former Palemar College QB, took over for Omer and in the fourth period directed USIU to its final 17 points.

The Westerners play at Chico State next Saturday before be-ginning the home portion of their 10-game schedule against Redlands at Balboa Stadium Oct. 10.
