

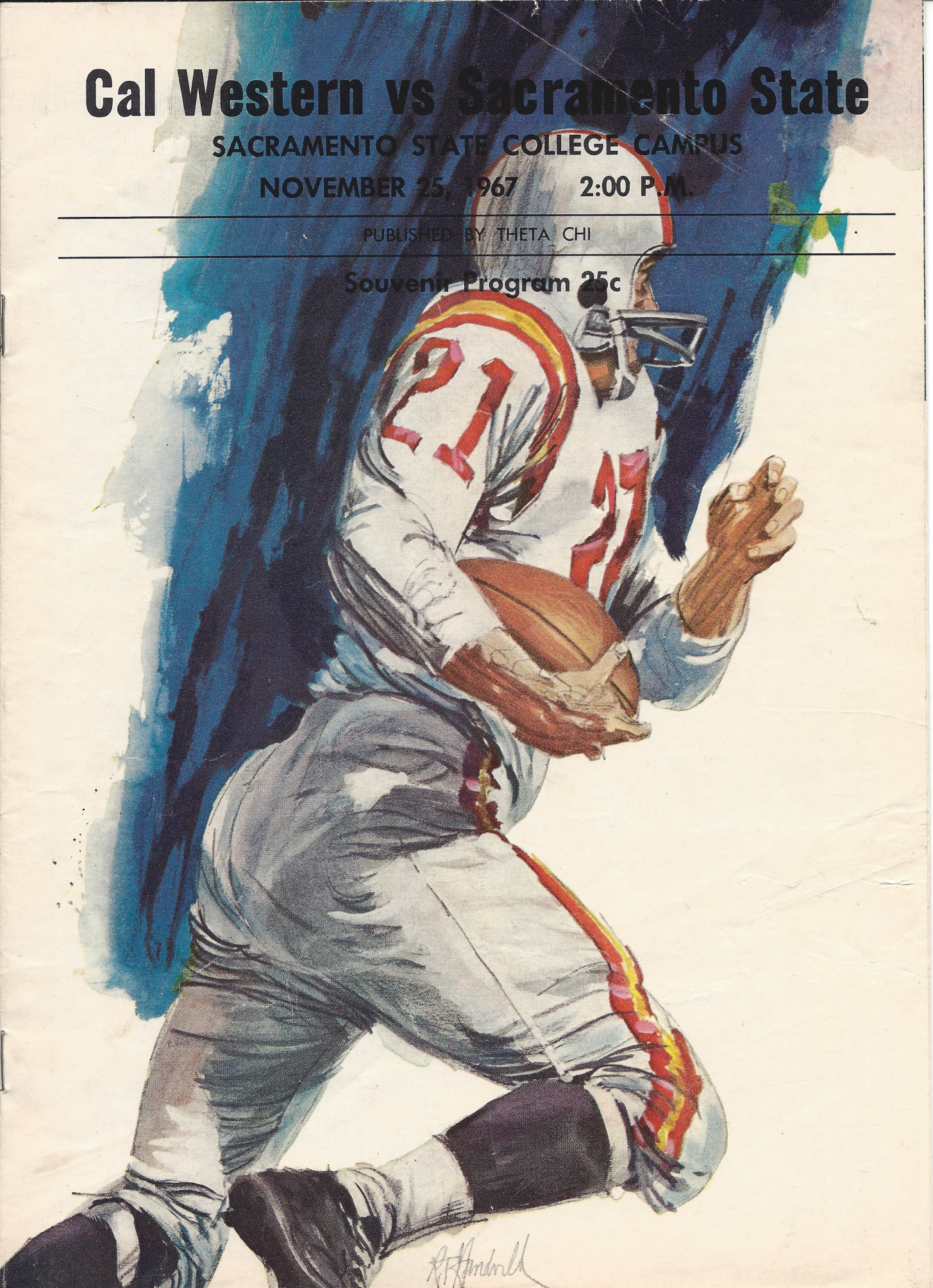

TODAY'S GAME

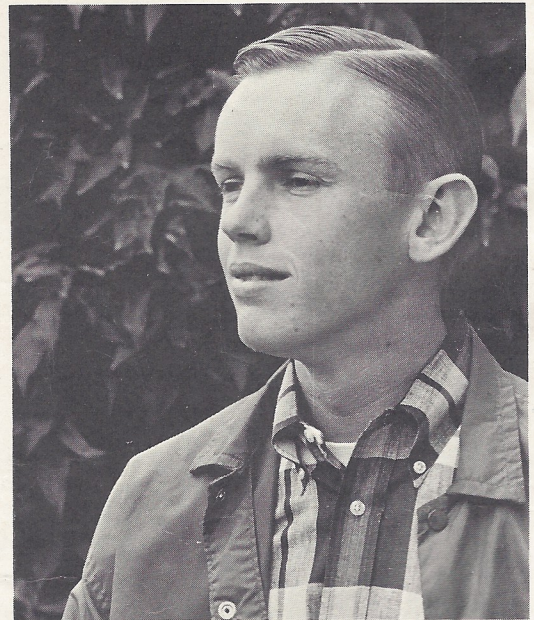

Sacramento State College winds up their 1967 football season today when they take on the tough Cal Western University of San Diego. The Westerners come into the game with a 7-2 record, having defeated the University of Redlands, the University of the Puget Sound, Cal Poly (SLO), Whittier College, La Verne College, California Lutheran College, and the College of Southern Utah. Cal Westerns two losses came at the hands of Eastern Washington State 44-19, and last week to the University of Hawaii 40-14.

They will be led by sophomore quarterback Wayne Clark, who is a former All-State high school back from Iowa. Fullback Jackman LeBlanc who runs the 100 yards in 9-7 is the Westerners leading ball carrier. In two seasons, he has packed the ball for 1133 yards for a 4.9 average.

Sacramento comes into today's game with a 6-3 record, having defeated Cal Poly Pomona, Portland State, Chico State, Cal State Hayward, Cal Aggies, and the University of Nevada. SSC has lost to San Francisco State, Cal Poly (SLO), and Humboldt State. The only common opponent to both SSC and Cal Western is Cal Poly (SLO). The Hornets lost 17-7, while the Westerners won 14-13.

Quarterback Lyle James, still nursing a foot injury will lead the Hornets into their final game. James, who has been playing sub-par with an injury for the last three games, has meant the difference between victory and defeat for SSC.

SACRAMENTO STATE COLLEGE

This photograph of the Sacramento State College campus was shot last winter by the Sacramento BEE during the final stages of completion of the Guy A. West footbridge across the American River from Campus Commons. (The bridge, by the way, was built with private capital and is being paid for by assessment against property in the Campus Commons development. No state funds were used in the construction project.)

The picture gives dramatic evidence of the recent growth and development of the SSC campus. In the foreground of the campus buildings is the new five-story Science Building which was completed this fall and opened by use in the instructional program. The building, in addition to faculty offices, contains laboratories and classrooms for courses in chemistry, physics, physical science, botany, environmental resources, and nursing.

Among the unique features of the building is an anechoic chamber where physical phenomena can be studied with almost total sound baffling. Also included is an electron microscope capable of magnification

100,000 times. In the basement are special quarters for experimental animals.

The building also contains an unusual glass blowing laboratory which allows professors and students to construct elaborate experimental equipment, particularly in the field of chemistry. Individual student research cubicles for biology students have been built in the basement surrounding a biological preparation room.

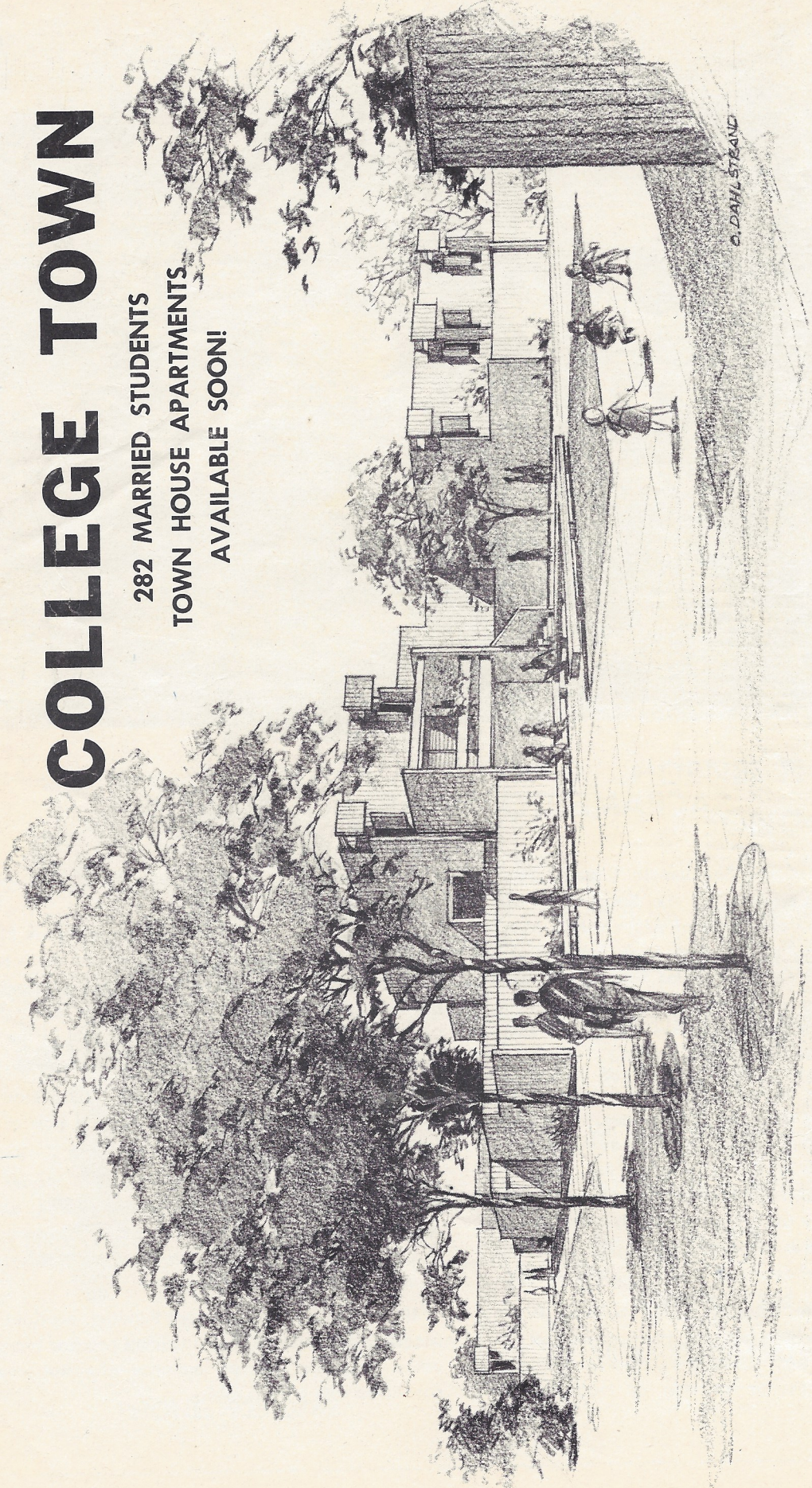
Also opened for fall classes is the \$2.2 million Music Building (far left background), actually a pair of structures joined by a center court.

The rehearsal performance wing, two stories high, contains a recital hall with a capacity of 364, and two rehearsal halls, one for choral and one for instrumental music. A central control room is equipped with extensive sound and recording equipment.

The office wing, a four-story building, provides classrooms, faculty offices, and individual practice rooms. The office wing and the performance-rehearsal wing are connected with a glass lobby.
