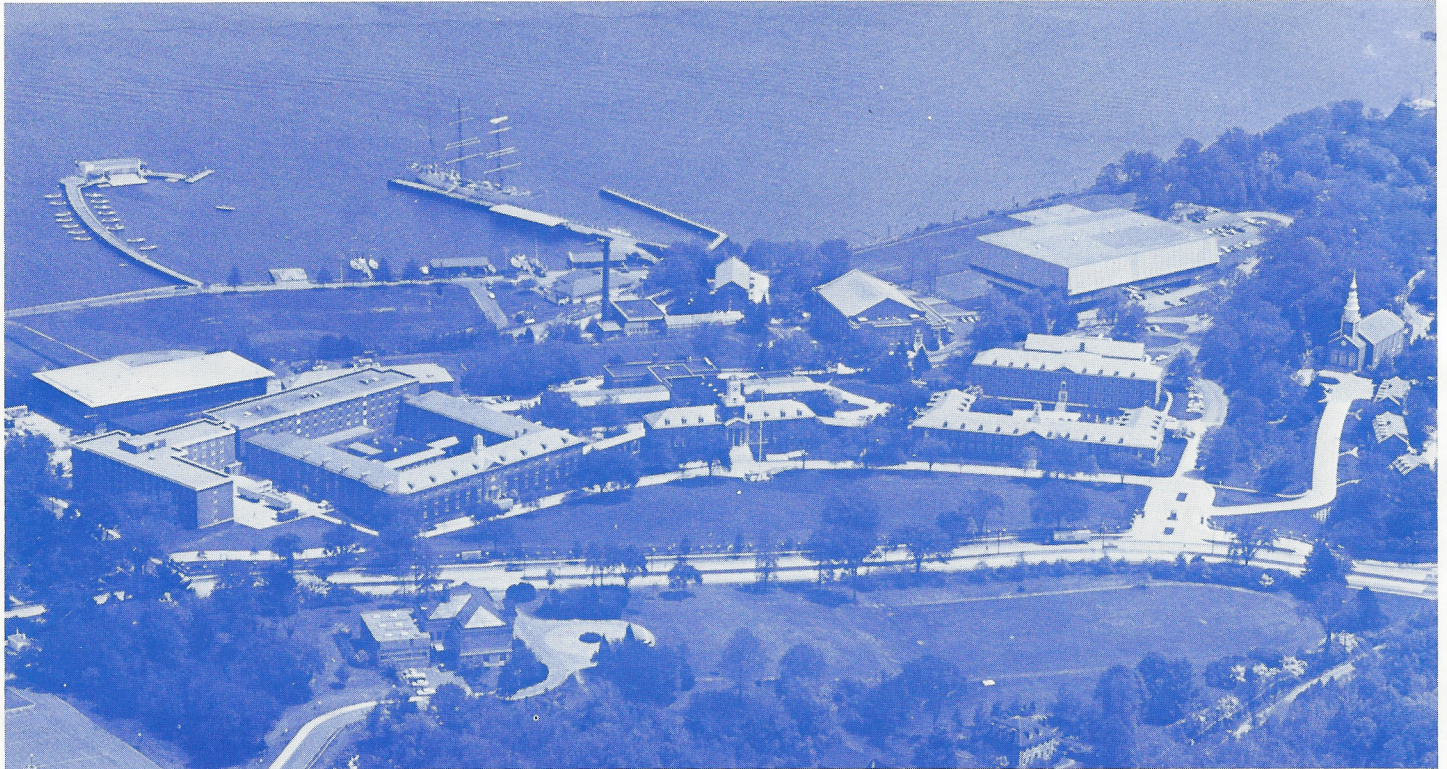

## THE ACADEMY HISTORY

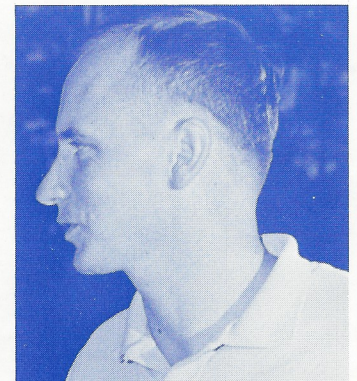
The Coast Guard Academy at New London, Conn., is maintained by the Federal Government for the professional and academic training of candidates for commissions in the United States Coast Guard.

Cadets are appointed to the Academy according to academic, mental, moral and physical qualifications as determined in nation-wide competitive exams conducted annually. The exams are given in conjunction with the College Boards in December.

The staff is made up of commissioned officers, commissioned professors and civilian officers. Capt. Paul F. Foye is the Academic Dean.

The Cadet system of the Coast Guard was established in 1876. Early that year the schooner Dobbins was commissioned as a training ship and put to sea from Baltimore with nine Cadets aboard. Currently the Academy has about 860 Cadets enrolled with the prospects of this number increasing sharply in the next few years.

In 1878 the 250-ton bark Chase replaced the Dobbins as a training ship and in 1900 winter quarters were transferred from New Bedford, Mass., to Arundel Cove near Baltimore. New London became the Academy home in 1910 at old Fort Trumbull and the present Academy site was obtained in 1929.
